- Rachel Redshaw, a graduate of Sabhal Mòr Ostaig, the Gaelic college on the Isle of Skye.

The Cànan agus Òran day will run from 9 am to 4 pm at Alumni Hall, 121 St. Joseph Street (Saint Michael's College, University of Toronto), Toronto, Ontario. The day will comprise of language classes and a song workshop. Classes will be offered at the Beginner, Intermediate, and Advanced levels. Should there be enough interest, a Beginner II (between beginner and intermediate) session will also be offered.

The cost for each day is \$40, free to U of T students, \$20 to non-U of T students and free to native speakers.
